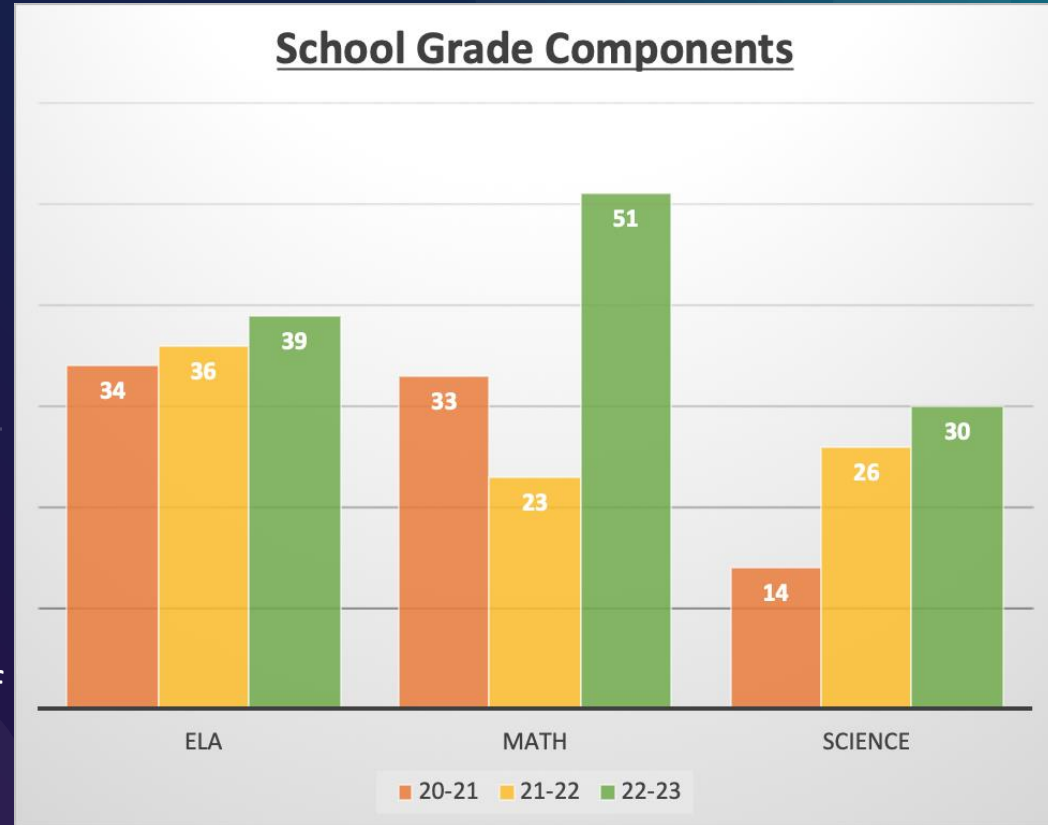
2022-2023 Data Comparison



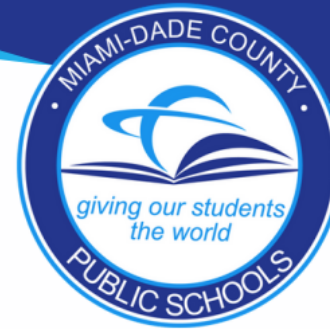
